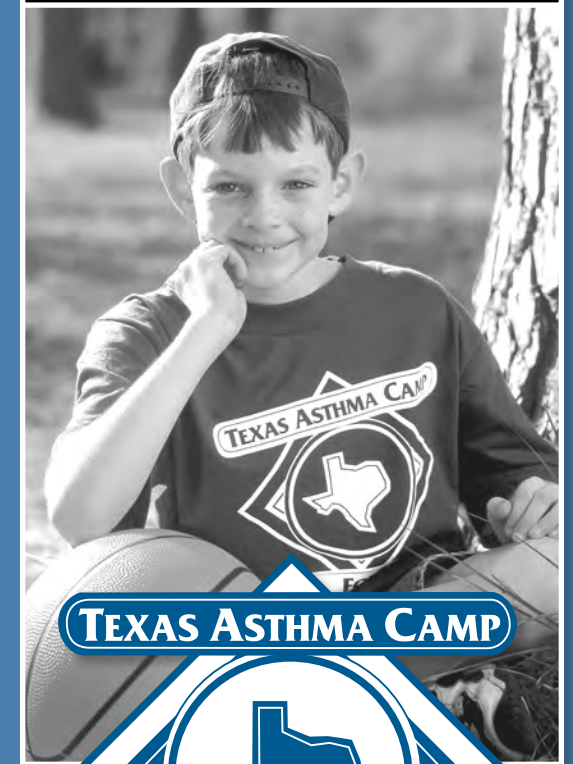

Texas Asthma Camp for Kids

ONE WEEK ONLY: June 13 - 18

Living with asthma can be scary and lonely, especially for a child. The Texas Asthma Camp for Kids (TAC) increases the courage and independence of children with asthma by taking away the mysteries of their asthma and showing them that they can be in control. TAC kids learn together how to take an active role in the management of their asthma during work and play.



- Your child will learn what happens to the lungs before and during an attack.
- He will learn his asthma triggers and warning signs.
- She will learn what to do about these signs.
- Your child will learn about all of the different types of asthma medications and what they do.
- He will learn what steps he can take on his own to better manage his asthma and avoid an attack.
- And your child will be taught how and when to use a peak flow meter.

Camper Selection

– Please Read Carefully –

The Texas Asthma Camp for Kids is now **one week only** (June 13-18). We will be selecting 75 campers, ages 7-14, on the basis of their age and the severity of their asthma. The number of years your child has attended TAC will also be considered. **A completed Registration Form and the registration fee of \$15 are due no later than Friday, May 7.** The registration fee is due even if you apply for financial aid. You will be notified the first week in May if your child has been selected to attend camp. **You will be sent a packet of information and additional forms to be completed that will be due by June 1, 2010.**

You will also be notified if your child is not selected to attend the 2010 camp, and your registration fee of \$15 will be refunded.

Camp Location and Staffing

The Texas Asthma Camp for Kids is located at Camp Tyler, four miles east of Whitehouse, Texas, on beautiful Lake Tyler. The cabins are air-conditioned, and the campers are housed by sex and age group. The majority of counselors are health professions students selected to ensure your child safely enjoys camping and educational activities.

Medical Care and Medications

The campers receive excellent medical support in a 24-hour clinic staffed by on-site physicians and nurses. Medications are very closely monitored according to the instructions of your child's doctor. Each camper will bring his or her own medications to camp.
